

## ANNEX I

### INTRODUCTION AND MOVEMENT OF THE SPECIFIED PLANTS

#### *Section 1*

##### **Specific requirements for introduction into the Union**

- (1) Without prejudice to the provisions listed in Directive 2000/29/EC, specified plants originating in a third country shall be accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate, as referred to in the first subparagraph of point (ii) of Article 13(1) of that Directive, which includes under the heading 'Additional declaration' the information that the specified plants have been found free from the specified organism immediately prior to leaving the third country concerned.
- (2) Specified plants introduced into the Union in accordance with point (1) shall be inspected at the point of entry or the place of destination established in accordance with Commission Directive 2004/103/EC<sup>(1)</sup> to confirm that they meet the requirements laid down in point (1).

#### *Section 2*

##### **Conditions for movement**

Specified plants originating in demarcated areas within the Union may be moved from such areas into non-demarcated areas within the Union if they are accompanied by a plant passport prepared and issued in accordance with Commission Directive 92/105/EEC<sup>(2)</sup>.
