This Directive concerns prohibition of the placing on the market
For the purposes of this Directive the following definitions shall
Member States shall ensure that plant protection products containing one
(1) By way of derogation from Article 3, Member States
The Directive shall not apply to plant protection products intended
(1) After consultation by the Commission of the Scientific Committee
(1) If it appears necessary, because of an unforeseeable danger
(1) The Commission shall be assisted by the Standing Committee
The Member States shall, not later than 1 January 1981,
This Directive is addressed to the Member States.
