

**COMMISSION DIRECTIVE**

of 15 November 1983

**amending Directive 83/201/EEC establishing exceptions from Council Directive 77/99/EEC for certain products which contain other foodstuffs and only a small percentage of meat or meat product**

(83/577/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Directive 77/99/EEC of 21 December 1976 on health problems affecting intra-Community trade in meat products <sup>(1)</sup>, and in particular Article 8 thereof,Whereas the Commission, by Directive 83/201/EEC <sup>(2)</sup>, established certain exceptions from Directive 77/99/EEC for certain products which contain other foodstuffs and only a small percentage of meat or meat product ;

Whereas it appeared to be necessary to give the Member States a supplementary delay for transposing the provisions of Directive 83/201/EEC into their national legislation ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Directive are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Veterinary Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DIRECTIVE :

*Article 1*

In Article 6 of Directive 83/201/EEC, '1 January 1984' is hereby replaced by '1 June 1984'.

*Article 2*

This Directive is addressed to the Member States.
