Council Directive of 21 December 1988 on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to quickfrozen foodstuffs for human consumption (89/108/EEC)

Article 4

The cryogenic media authorized, to the exclusion of all others, for use in direct contact with quick-frozen foodstuffs shall be the following:

- air,
- nitrogen,
- carbon dioxide.

By way of derogation from the first paragraph, Member States may retain until 31 December 1992 national laws authorizing the use of dichlorodifluoromethane (R 12) as a cryogenic medium.

[^{F1}The purity criteria to be satisfied by those cryogenic media shall be determined, as far as necessary, by the Commission. Those measures, designed to amend non-essential elements of this Directive by supplementing it, shall be adopted in accordance with the regulatory procedure with scrutiny referred to in Article 12(2).]
