

Council Directive of 21 May 1991 concerning  
urban waste water treatment (91/271/EEC)

*Article 17*

1 Member States shall by 31 December 1993 establish a programme for the implementation of this Directive.

[<sup>F1</sup>By way of derogation from the first subparagraph, in respect of Mayotte, France shall establish a programme for the implementation of this Directive by 30 June 2014.]

2 Member States shall by 30 June 1994 provide the Commission with information on the programme.

[<sup>F1</sup>By way of derogation from the first subparagraph, in respect of Mayotte, France shall provide the Commission with information on the programme by 31 December 2014.]

3 Member States shall, if necessary, provide the Commission by 30 June every two years with an update of the information described in paragraph 2.

[<sup>F24</sup> The Commission shall determine, in accordance with the regulatory procedure referred to in Article 18(2), the methods and formats to be adopted for reporting on the national programmes. Any amendments to those methods and formats shall be adopted in accordance with that procedure.]

5 The Commission shall every two years review and assess the information received pursuant to paragraphs 2 and 3 above and publish a report thereon.
