Directive 2001/24/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 April 2001 on the reorganisation and winding up of credit institutions

TITLE I

SCOPE AND DEFINITIONS

Article 1

Scope

- This Directive shall apply to credit institutions and their branches set up in Member States other than those in which they have their head offices, as defined in points (1) and (3) of Article 1 of Directive 2000/12/EC, subject to the conditions and exemptions laid down in Article 2(3) of that Directive.
- The provisions of this Directive concerning the branches of a credit institution having a head office outside the Community shall apply only where that institution has branches in at least two Member States of the Community.
- [F13] This Directive shall also apply to investment firms as defined in point (2) of Article 4(1) of Regulation (EU) No 575/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council⁽¹⁾ and their branches located in Member States other than those in which they have their head offices.
- In the event of application of the resolution tools and exercise of the resolution powers provided for in Directive 2014/59/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council⁽²⁾, this Directive shall also apply to the financial institutions, firms and parent undertakings falling within the scope of Directive 2014/59/EU.
- 5 Articles 4 and 7 of this Directive shall not apply where Article 83 of Directive 2014/59/ EU applies.
- 6 Article 33 of this Directive shall not apply where Article 84 of Directive 2014/59/EU applies.]
