- ____ its geographical area or region;
- _____ the zoonoses and/or zoonotic agents concerned;
- the type of samples and other data units requested;
- minimum sampling schemes;
- ____ the type of laboratory testing methods;
- the tasks of competent authorities;
- ____ the resources to be allocated;
- ____ the estimation of its costs and how they will be covered; and
- the method and time of reporting the results.
