14. In Annex IV, Part A, Section I, a new point 7.3. is added:

7.3. Isolated bark of conifers (Coniferales), originating in non-European countries

Official statement that the isolated bark:

- has been subjected to an (a) appropriate fumigation with a fumigant approved in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 18.2. There shall be evidence thereof by indicating on the certificates referred to in Article 13.1.(ii), the active ingredient, the minimum bark temperature, the rate (g/m^3) and the exposure time (h),
- (b) has undergone an appropriate heat treatment to achieve the minimum temperature of 56 °C for at least 30 minutes, the latter to be indicated on the certificates referred to in Article 13.1.(ii).
