

REGULATION (EEC) No 517/68 OF THE COUNCIL

of 29 April 1968

supplementing Regulation No 120/67/EEC as regards the refund to be granted on cereal products exported in the form of chemical products

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof;

Annex B to Regulation No 120/67/EEC shall be supplemented as follows:

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

ex 29.04 C II	Sorbitol
ex 29.16	Sorbitol esters; glyceric acid, glycollic acid, saccharonic acid, isosaccharonic acid, heptasaccharic acid, and their salts and esters

ex 29.35 S	Anhydric compounds of sorbitol (as for example sorbitans), not including maltol and isomaltol
ex 29.43 B	Sorbose, its salts and esters; methyl glucosides
38.19 Q II	Foundry core binders based on synthetic resins
ex 39.19 Q IV	Sorbitol cracking products
ex 39.02	Adhesives based on resin emulsions and on sodium silicate emulsions
ex 39.06 B	Other high polymers, artificial resins and artificial plastic materials

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament¹;

Whereas Article 16 of Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC² of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in cereals provides for granting refunds on cereal products exported in the form of goods listed in Annex B to that Regulation; whereas that Annex includes goods containing large quantities of such products, with the exception however of sorbitol and certain of its derivatives and other products which may also be obtained from cereals; whereas experience has proved that the absence of refunds makes it difficult to export the agricultural products in question in the above-mentioned forms;

Article 2

Whereas therefore an export refund should also be granted on the above-mentioned cereal products which are processed into such goods; whereas consequently Annex B to Regulation No 120/67/EEC should be supplemented accordingly;

This regulation shall enter into force on 1 May 1968.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
