THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 227 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas the Community provisions relative to the establishment of common rules for exports should also apply in the French overseas departments;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1 U.K.

The provisions of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2603/69⁽¹⁾ of 20 December 1969 establishing common rules for exports shall apply in the French overseas departments.

Article 2 U.K.

This Regulation shall enter into force on 31 December 1969.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
