REGULATION (EEC) No 347/71 OF THE COUNCIL

of 15 February 1971

amending the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Nuclear Research Centre employed in the Netherlands

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) No 259/68¹ of 29 February 1968 on the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Communities and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the Communities, and in particular the second paragraph of Article 4 and Articles 94 and 95 of those Conditions of Employment;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 11/65/EURATOM² of 16 March 1965 laying down the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Nuclear Research Centre employed in the Netherlands, as last amended by Council Regulation (EURATOM) No 966/70³ of 25 May 1970, and in particular Article 13 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas it is for the Council, acting on a proposal from the Commission, to lay down, in the light of local practice, the conditions governing remuneration for establishment staff of the Joint Nuclear Research Centre at each place of employment;

Whereas, in view of the changes in salaries made since 1 January 1970 for staff of the *Reactor Centrum Nederland*, Regulation No 11/65/Euratom should be further amended;

Article 1

The following Articles 3b and 3c shall be added to Regulation No 11/65/Euratom:

'Article 3b

For the year 1970, establishment staff employed on 1 August 1970 shall receive a single allowance amounting to 2.78% of their annual salary, the latter being calculated on the basis of the monthly salary in force on 1 August 1970, including rent allowance, leave allowance and the monthly allowance in force on 1 August 1970 for dependent children, taking into account the number of children dependent on the member concerned at 1 August 1970.

A member of establishment staff who has not completed seven months' service on 1 August 1970 or whose service terminated before 31 December 1970 shall be granted a single allowance calculated on the basis of the number of months' service completed, any period of fifteen or more days being counted as a full month and any period of less than fifteen days being disregarded.

Article 3c

The increase in the contributions provided for in the Algemene Ouderdomswet and in the Algemene Weduwen en Wezenwet, due to take effect on 1 July 1970, shall be off-set up to 80%, with a maximum of fl 9·36 per month of service completed between 1 July 1970 and 31 December 1970.'

Article 2

The following shall be substituted for the Annex to Regulation No 11/65/Euratom, from 1 January 1971:
