

## REGULATION (EEC) No 1414/72 OF THE COUNCIL

of 27 June 1972

extending to other imports the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 109/70 establishing common rules for imports from state-trading countries

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

*Article 1*

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 109/70 of 19 December 1969<sup>1</sup> establishing common rules for imports from state-trading countries, and in particular Article 2 thereof;

The Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 109/70 shall be extended to include imports into the Community from the third countries indicated by an asterisk of the products listed in the Annex to this Regulation.

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

*Article 2*

Whereas in respect of certain products quantitative restrictions have been removed in all Member States as regards Bulgaria, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Czechoslovakia, the USSR, Albania, the People's Republic of China, North Vietnam, North Korea and Mongolia;

The Commission is authorized to publish the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 109/70 in the version as extended by Regulations (EEC) Nos 1492/70,<sup>2</sup> 2172/70,<sup>3</sup> 2567/70,<sup>4</sup> 532/71,<sup>5</sup> 725/71,<sup>6</sup> 1073/71,<sup>7</sup> 1074/71,<sup>8</sup> 2386/71,<sup>9</sup> 2406/71,<sup>10</sup> 2407/71,<sup>11</sup> and by this Regulation.

Whereas the extension of the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 109/70 to include imports of those products from those countries into the Community is not liable to create a situation where the application of protective measures as provided for in Title IV of that Regulation would be justified;

*Article 3*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

Whereas the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 109/70 may accordingly be extended to include the imports in question;
