

REGULATION (EEC) No 1422/72 OF THE COMMISSION

of 4 July 1972

amending Regulation (EEC) No 1492/71 fixing the procedure and conditions for the taking over of cereals by intervention agencies

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Article 1

The second sentence of the second indent of Article 2 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 1492/71 shall be deleted.

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organization of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 796/72² and in particular Article 7 (5) thereof;

Article 2

The following shall be substituted for the eleventh indent of Article 2 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 1492/71:

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1492/71³ of 13 July 1971 fixing the procedure and conditions for the taking over of cereals by intervention agencies, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1737/71,⁴ lays down for the 1971/72 marketing year a moisture content for cereals of 14 to 18% instead of 14 to 16% and a percentage of shrivelled barley grains of 25% instead of 15%; whereas the original percentages should be reintroduced for the 1972/73 marketing year as regards both the moisture content and the shrivelled grains;

'— the percentage of shrivelled barley grains does not exceed 15%.'

Article 3

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 1492/71, although relevant to the 1971/72 marketing year, covers cereals harvested in 1971 but not those harvested in 1972 in very different climatic conditions;

The following paragraph shall be added to Article 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 1492/71:

Whereas the Management Committee for Cereals has not delivered an Opinion within the time limit set by its Chairman;

'5. The procedures and conditions for taking over cereals offered for intervention during June and July shall be those fixed by this Regulation for the following marketing year.'

Article 4

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.
