REGULATION (EEC) No 2269/72 OF THE COMMISSION

of 26 October 1972

supplementing Regulation (EEC) No 1576/72 on the differential amounts
for colza and rape seed

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organization of the market in oils and fats,¹ as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1547/72²;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1569/72 of 20 July 1972 laying down special measures for colza and rape seed,³ and in particular Articles 2 (2) and 7 thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1576/72 of 24 July 1972 on the differential amounts for colza and rape seed⁴ provides for the levying or granting of differential amounts for seeds harvested in the Community during the 1972/73 marketing year and placed under control at an oil mill or exported during the period from 26 July 1972 to 30 June 1973; whereas, for the purpose of granting or levying these amounts in respect of seeds which have been the subject of intra-Community trade, that Regulation provides that use should be made of the document introduced by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2315/69 of 19 November 1969 on the use of Community transit documents for the purpose of applying Community measures for verifying the use and/or destination of goods⁵;

Whereas it appears that some seeds harvested during the 1972/73 marketing year were despatched from one Member State to another before 26 July 1972 and were placed under control or exported after that date; whereas the control copy necessary for payment of the differential amounts could not be issued for these products; whereas provisions should therefore

be made to allow payment of any differential amounts in respect of these seeds where the document referred to above is not available;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Oil and Fats;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following Article 10a shall be added to Regulation (EEC) No 1576/72:

'Article 10a

Where seeds harvested in the Community during the 1972/73 marketing year have undergone customs formalities for despatch to another Member State during the period from 1 to 25 July 1972 and where in respect of these seeds in the latter Member State:

- the ID part of the certificate provided for in Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 2114/71 has been applied for; or
- customs export formalities have been completed

after the said period, the differential amounts shall, where appropriate, be granted to the parties concerned against production of such evidence as shall be determined by the competent authorities of the relevant Member State.

The evidence must provide guarantees equivalent to those provided by the control copy referred to in Article 5.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.
