REGULATION (EEC) No 2816/72 OF THE COMMISSION

of 22 December 1972

derogating from Regulation (EEC) No 1173/68 as regards the amount of security to be given upon importation of young bovine animals and calves for fattening

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COM-MUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68¹ of 27 June 1968 on the com-mon organisation of the market in beef and veal, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2838/71,² and in particular Article 11 (2) thereof;

Whereas the benefit of the special import system provided for in Article 11 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 is conditional on the giving of security guaranteeing compliance with Article 2 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1173/683 of 2 August 1968 on special import terms for certain categories of young bovine animals and calves, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 390/694; whereas the amount of security was fixed by Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 1173/68 in a sum equal to the amounts exempted from charge by virtue of Article 11 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68;

Whereas the levies and customs duties in respect of young bovine animals and calves which are subject to the special system provided for in Article 11 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 were suspended until 31 January 1973 by Council Regulations (EEC) No 2324/72⁵ of 31 October 1972 and No 2457/726 of 21 November 1972 suspending respectively the autonomous Common Customs Tariff duties and the levies applicable to beef and veal;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

By way of derogation from Regulation (EEC) No 1173/68 the amount of the security under Article 4 (2) thereof shall until 31 January 1973 be equal to 8% of the value for customs purposes of young bovine animals or calves referred to in Article 11 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 18 December 1972.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
