

REGULATION (EEC) No 2156/75 OF THE COMMISSION**of 18 August 1975****altering the refunds applicable to cereals and wheat or rye flour groats and meal**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/
EEC⁽¹⁾ of 13 June 1967 on the common organization
of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regula-
tion (EEC) No 665/75⁽²⁾, and in particular the second
sentence of the fourth subparagraph of Article 16 (2)
thereof;

Whereas the export refunds on cereals and on wheat
or rye flour groats and meal were fixed by Regulation
(EEC) No 2078/75⁽³⁾, amended by Regulation (EEC)
No 2098/75⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas it follows from applying the rules, criteria
and other provisions contained in Regulation (EEC)

No 2078/75 to the information at present available to
the Commission that the export refunds at present in
force should be altered as shown in the Annex to this
Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The refunds on the products listed in Article 1 (a), (b)
and (c) of Regulation No 120/67/EEC, exported in the
natural state, as fixed in the Annex to amended Regu-
lation (EEC) No 2078/75, are hereby altered as shown
in the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 19 August
1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
