COUNCIL REGULATION (EURATOM) No 2310/76

of 20 September 1976

amending the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Research Centre employed in Belgium

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of officials and the conditions of employment of other servants of the European Communities laid down in Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68 (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC), No 2577/75 (2), and in particular Article 94 of the conditions of employment of other servants of the European Communities,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas, by Regulation No 10/63/Euratom (3), as last amended by Regulation (Euratom) No 2868/75 (4), the Council laid down the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Research Centre employed in Belgium;

Whereas the changes in salaries made in the course of 1976 in favour of the staff of the Belgian Centre for Nuclear Studies (CEN) justify a further amendment of Regulation No 10/63/Euratom,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The third paragraph of Article 3 of Regulation No 10/63/Euratom shall be replaced by the following paragraph:

'Each member of the establishment staff shall receive for the year 1976 a single amount equal to the amount of his basic salary for the month of June 1976, weighted according to the cost-ofliving index for that month. This payment shall be subject to the deduction of social security contributions. Where employment commences or ceases during 1976 the payment shall be made in proportion to the period of service accomplished.'

With effect from 1 January 1975 the following salary scale, drawn up on the basis of the trigger index 96.05 (base year 1971), shall be substituted for the salary scale appearing in the Annex to Regulation No 10/63/Euratom:
