

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2792/77
of 15 December 1977
amending Regulation (EEC) No 2604/77 introducing monetary compensatory
amounts in respect of durum wheat and the products derived therefrom

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
974/71 of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of
conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture
following the temporary widening of the margins of
fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member
States⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No
557/76⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 6 thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2604/77
of 25 November 1977 introducing monetary compen-
satory amounts in respect of durum wheat and the
products derived therefrom⁽³⁾ provides that these
amounts are to be applied to the products in question
after the expiry of a transitional period, namely, with
effect from 2 January 1978; whereas, in order to deal
better with certain situations, all parties concerned
who have fixed the export refund or import levy in
advance should be permitted to carry out the relevant
operations without having to pay monetary compensa-
tory amounts; whereas, however, this entitlement
should be limited to those cases where it was not
known at the time of the advance fixing that the said
amounts were to be reintroduced;

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.

Done at Brussels, 15 December 1977.

Whereas on these grounds Regulation (EEC) No
2604/77 must be amended;

Whereas the Management Committee for Cereals has
not delivered an opinion within the time limit set by
its chairman,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The following paragraph is hereby added to Article 2
of Regulation (EEC) No 2604/77 :

'On application in writing by the party concerned,
this Regulation shall not apply to operations
carried out under cover of a certificate fixing the
export refund or the import levy in advance in
respect of which the application was lodged prior
to 26 November 1977.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its
publication in the *Official Journal of the European
Communities*.
