### COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2839/77

#### of 19 December 1977

# extending the period of validity of Community surveillance over imports of certain phosphate fertilizers

# THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1439/74 of 4 June 1974 on common rules for imports (1), and in particular Article 7 thereof,

Consultations having been held within the committee set up under Article 5 of the said Regulation,

Whereas, by Regulation (EEC) No 440/77 of 1 March 1977 (<sup>2</sup>), the Commission established Community surveillance over imports of certain phosphate fertilizers;

Whereas the reasons which originally led the Commission to take such action, that is to say the considerable pressure exercised by imports into the Community of certain phosphate fertilizers and the resultant threat of injury to Community producers of like or directly competing products, continue to apply;

Whereas it is necessary to prolong surveillance,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

## Article 1

The period of validity of Regulation (EEC) No 440/77 is hereby extended to 31 December 1978.

### Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1978. It shall apply until 31 December 1978.
