allocating the Community quantitative export quotas for certain types of copper ash and residues and for certain types of copper, aluminium and lead waste and scrap

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1023/70 of 25 May 1970 establishing a common procedure for administering quantitative quotas (1), and in particular Article 2 thereof,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2878/77 of 20 December 1977 fixing for the first four months of 1978 Community quantitative export quotas for certain types of copper ash and residues and for certain types of copper, aluminium and lead waste and scrap (2), and in particular Article 2 thereof,

Whereas, in accordance with Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) No 2878/77 the quotas are to be allocated

according to estimated needs and with regard to the export opportunities that already exist for the products in question;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion delivered by the Quota Administration Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The Community quantitative export quotas opened by Regulation (EEC) No 2878/77 for the period 1 January to 30 April 1978 shall be allocated among the Member States as follows:
