

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2858/79
of 18 December 1979

**on the adjustment coefficients applicable to monetary compensatory amounts
fixed in advance between 12 and 16 December 1979**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
974/71 of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of
conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture
following the temporary widening of the margins of
fluctuation of the currencies of certain Member
States⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No
987/79⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 3 thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC) No
1516/78 of 30 June 1978 on the obligatory adjust-
ments to be made to monetary compensatory amounts
fixed in advance and repealing Regulation (EEC) No
651/78⁽³⁾, and in particular Article 1 (2) thereof,

Whereas the monetary compensatory amounts intro-
duced by Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 were fixed by
Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2140/79 of 28
September 1979⁽⁴⁾, as last amended by Regulation
(EEC) No 2839/79⁽⁵⁾;

Whereas Article 7 (1) of Commission Regulation
(EEC) No 243/78 of 1 February 1978 providing for
the advance fixing of monetary compensatory
amounts⁽⁶⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No
1544/78⁽⁷⁾, provides that the monetary compensatory

amounts fixed in advance must be adjusted if a new
representative rate comes into effect during the period
of validity of the certificate;

Whereas on 12 December 1979 the Council
published its decision to adjust the representative rates
in the case of the Italian lira and the pound sterling;
whereas it is necessary, therefore, with effect from 12
December 1979, to fix adjustment coefficients for
advance fixings carried out between 12 and 16
December 1979 for sectors in respect of which the
new representative rates take effect on 17 December
1979,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The coefficients making the adjustments pursuant to
Article 7 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 243/78 to mone-
tary compensatory amounts fixed in advance appear in
the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 19
December 1979.

It shall apply from 12 to 16 December 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.

ANNEX

Adjustments to be made pursuant to Article 7 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 243/78 to monetary compensatory amounts fixed in advance

The monetary compensatory amounts referred to in Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 2140/79 and fixed in advance as from 12 December 1979 are multiplied by the following coefficients :
