

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 3311/85
of 18 November 1985

amending Regulation (EEC) No 338/79 laying down special provisions relating to quality
wines produced in specified regions

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission ⁽¹⁾,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament ⁽²⁾,

Whereas according to the second paragraph of Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) No 358/79 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3310 ⁽⁴⁾, the provisions of that Regulation, with the exception of Title II, apply also, from 1 January 1985, to quality sparkling wines produced in specified regions as defined in Regulation (EEC) No 338/79 ⁽⁵⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 798/85 ⁽⁶⁾;

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 3310/85 provides for the insertion in Article 16 of Regulation (EEC) No 358/79 of

provisions relating to the maximum level of sulphur dioxide in quality sparkling wines produced in specified regions; whereas, in consequence thereof, Article 13 of Regulation (EEC) No 338/79 should, for reasons of clarity, be repealed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 13 of Regulation (EEC) No 338/79 is hereby repealed.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall apply from 1 September 1986.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
