

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3572/85**  
of 18 December 1985

**amending Regulations (EEC) No 1892/85, (EEC) No 2923/85, (EEC) No 2924/85, (EEC) No 2946/85, (EEC) No 2964/85, (EEC) No 3052/85, (EEC) No 3072/85, (EEC) No 3142/85, (EEC) No 3187/85, (EEC) No 3217/85, (EEC) No 3228/85 and (EEC) No 3434/85 opening standing invitations to tender for the export of cereals held by the intervention agencies**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1018/84<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 7 (5) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1836/82 of 7 July 1982 laying down the procedure and conditions for the disposal of cereals held by the intervention agencies<sup>(3)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3447/85<sup>(4)</sup>,

Whereas the last partial invitation to tender under Regulations (EEC) No 1892/85<sup>(5)</sup>, (EEC) No 2923/85<sup>(6)</sup>, (EEC) No 2924/85<sup>(7)</sup>, (EEC) No 2946/85<sup>(8)</sup>, (EEC) No 2964/85<sup>(9)</sup>, (EEC) No 3052/85<sup>(10)</sup>, (EEC) No 3072/85<sup>(11)</sup>, (EEC) No 3142/85<sup>(12)</sup>, (EEC) No 3187/85<sup>(13)</sup>, (EEC) No 3217/85<sup>(14)</sup>, (EEC) No 3228/85<sup>(15)</sup> and (EEC) No 3434/85<sup>(16)</sup> should be postponed;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Article 4 (3) of Regulations (EEC) No 1892/85, (EEC) No 2923/85, (EEC) No 2924/85, (EEC) No 2946/85, (EEC) No 2964/85, (EEC) No 3052/85, (EEC) No 3072/85, (EEC) No 3142/85, (EEC) No 3187/85, (EEC) No 3217/85, (EEC) No 3228/85, and (EEC) No 3434/85 is replaced by the following:

'3. The last partial invitation to tender shall expire on 30 April 1986.'

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
