

**COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 3913/87  
of 21 December 1987**

**concerning the extension of certain provisions of Regulation (EEC) No 797/85  
applicable in the pig production sector**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 797/85 of 12 March 1985 on improving the efficiency of agricultural structures <sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1760/87 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 3 (4) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas the arrangements laid down in Article 3 (4) of Regulation (EEC) No 797/85 for granting aid for investments in the pig production sector expire on 31 December 1987; whereas the application of these arrangements should be extended until 31 March 1988 with a view to their revision before that date,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The arrangements concerning the conditions for granting aid for investments in the pig production sector applicable, under Article 3 (4) of Regulation (EEC) No 797/85, to requests submitted between 1 January 1987 and 31 December 1987, are hereby extended until 31 March 1988.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1988.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
