

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 403/87**of 9 February 1987****suspending standing invitations to tender for the export of barley held by the intervention agencies**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1579/86 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 ⁽⁵⁾ thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1836/82 of 7 July 1982 laying down the procedure and conditions for the disposal of cereals held by the intervention agencies ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 124/87 ⁽⁴⁾,

Whereas it is convenient to suspend the tenders under Commission Regulations (EEC) No 2846/86 ⁽⁵⁾ and (EEC) No 2848/86 ⁽⁶⁾;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The tenders under Regulations (EEC) No 2846/86 and (EEC) No 2848/86 are hereby suspended.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
