COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3493/92

of 2 December 1992

altering the export refunds on white sugar and raw sugar exported in the natural state

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1785/81 of 30 June 1981 on the common organization of the markets in the sugar sector (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 61/92 (2), and in particular the second subparagraph of Article 19 (4) thereof,

Whereas the refunds on white sugar and raw sugar exported in the natural state were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3379/92 (3), as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3451/92 (4);

Whereas it follows from applying the detailed rules contained in amended Regulation (EEC) No 3379/92 to the information known to the Commission that the export refunds at present in force should be altered to the amounts set out in the Annex hereto,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The export refunds on the products listed in Article 1 (1) (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 1785/81, undenatured and exported in the natural state, as fixed in the Annex to amended Regulation (EEC) No 3379/92 are hereby altered to the amounts shown in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 3 December 1992.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
