

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3790/92
of 28 December 1992
repealing Regulation (EEC) No 3437/92 suspending advance fixing of export
refunds for certain products processed from maize

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1738/92 ⁽²⁾, and in particular the first subparagraph of Article 16 (7) thereof,

Whereas Article 16 (7) of Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 makes provision for the suspension of arrangements relating to the advance fixing of export refunds if the market situation indicates that the said arrangements are causing difficulties or if such difficulties are in danger of arising;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3437/92 ⁽³⁾ suspended advance fixing of the export refund for certain products processed from maize; whereas under present

circumstances suspension of advance fixing is no longer necessary; whereas Regulation (EEC) No 3437/92 should therefore be repealed;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. Regulation (EEC) No 3437/92 is hereby repealed.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1993.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
