COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 3000/94

of 9 December 1994

derogating from Regulation (EEC) No 3929/87 as regards the final date for submission of the grape harvest declaration in the Region of Piedmont (Italy) for the 1994/95 wine year

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 822/87 of 16 March 1987 on the common organization of the market in wine ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1891/94 ⁽²⁾ and in particular Article 3 (4) thereof,

Whereas Article 5 (1) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3929/87 of 17 December 1987 on harvest, production and stock declarations relating to wine-sector products ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1991/94 ⁽⁴⁾, lays down 15 December as the final date for submission to the competent authorities of the harvest and production declarations for wine-making grapes; whereas as a result of exceptional atmospheric conditions in a production region in Italy, provision should be made to derogate from the aforementioned date in order to make it possible for vine growers to proceed with the completion of the harvest of fresh grapes and their vinification, which have been held up by bad weather;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Wine,

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
