

COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 2390/95

of 11 October 1995

amending Regulation (EEC) No 1538/91 introducing detailed rules for implementing Regulation (EEC) No 1906/90 on certain marketing standards for poultrymeat

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1906/90 of 26 June 1990 on certain marketing standards for poultrymeat⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 3204/93⁽²⁾, and in particular Articles 7 and 9 thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1538/91⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 3239/94⁽⁴⁾, lays down the detailed rules for implementing marketing standards in the poultrymeat sector;

Whereas, in the light of experience, certain definitions concerning foie gras, and carcase presentation should be amended;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Poultrymeat and Eggs,

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 1538/91 is hereby amended as follows:

1. The first indent of the third subparagraph of Article 1 (3) is replaced by the following:

‘— duck livers shall weigh at least 300 g net.’

2. The second and the third indents of Article 2 (1) are replaced by the following:

‘— with giblets,
— without giblets.’

The word “eviscerated” may be added.’

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the seventh day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
