▼B**COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 693/95****of 30 March 1995****amending Regulation (EEC) No 1756/93 fixing the operative events for the agricultural conversion rate applicable to milk and milk products**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3813/92 of 28 December 1992 on the unit of account and the conversion rates to be applied for the purposes of the common agricultural policy⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 150/95⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 6 (2) thereof,

Whereas the purpose of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1756/93⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 267/95⁽⁴⁾, is precisely to fix the agricultural conversion rate to be applied to all amounts fixed in ecus in the milk and milk products sector; whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 685/69 of 14 April 1969 on detailed rules of application for intervention on the market in butter and cream⁽⁵⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 393/94⁽⁶⁾, is repealed and replaced by Commission Regulation (EC) No 454/95⁽⁷⁾; whereas, therefore, the references in the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1756/93 should be amended;

Whereas the provisions on the validity of the aid voucher laid down in Article 2 (1) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2191/81 of 31 July 1981 on the granting of aid for the purchase of butter by non-profit-making institutions and organizations⁽⁸⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 455/95⁽⁹⁾; whereas the operative event relating thereto should therefore be adjusted;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1756/93 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Point 1 of Part B.I is replaced by the following:

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
