CHAPTER 11

SHEEP AND GOAT PREMIUMS

Article 115

Common provisions

1 Premiums shall be paid to recipient farmers on the basis of the number of ewes and/ or she-goats kept on their holding over a minimum period to be determined in accordance with the procedure referred to in Article 144(2).

 $[^{F1}2$ Once Council Regulation (EC) No 21/2004 establishing system for the identification and registration of ovine and caprine animals and amending Regulation (EEC)No 1782/2003 becomes applicable, to qualify for the premium an animal shall be identified and registered inaccordance with these rules.]
