CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

*[<sup>F1</sup>Article 2A*

**Definition of appropriate authority**

1. Subject to paragraph 2, ‘the appropriate authority’ means—
  - a in relation to England, the Secretary of State;
  - b in relation to Scotland, the Scottish Ministers;
  - d in relation to Wales, the Welsh Ministers.
2. But the appropriate authority is the Secretary of State if consent is given by—
  - a in relation to Scotland, the Scottish Ministers;
  - c in relation to Wales, in respect of the power to make regulations under Articles 4, 5, 8 11 and 12, the Welsh Ministers.]
