## **SECTION 5**

# **Export authorisation**

Article 18

The period of validity of the export authorisation within which the goods must have left the [F1 customs territory of the Union] shall not exceed six months from the date of issue of the export authorisation. Under exceptional circumstances, the period of validity may be extended, upon request.
