Commission Regulation (EC) No 1689/2005 of 14 October 2005 fixing the depreciation coefficients to be applied when agricultural products are bought in, for the 2006 financial year

Article 1

In respect of the products listed in the Annex which, having been bought in by public intervention, have entered store or been taken over by the intervention agencies between 1 October 2005 and 30 September 2006, the intervention agencies shall apply, to the value of the products bought in every month, the coefficients set out in the Annex.

Article 2

The expenditure amounts, calculated by taking account of the depreciation referred to in Article 1 shall be notified to the Commission under the declarations established pursuant to Commission Regulation (EC) No 296/96⁽¹⁾.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal* of the European Union.

This Regulation shall apply from 1 October 2005.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
