

Regulation (EC) No 183/2005 of the European Parliament  
and of the Council of 12 January 2005 laying down  
requirements for feed hygiene (Text with EEA relevance)

CHAPTER I

**SUBJECT MATTER, SCOPE AND DEFINITIONS**

*Article 2*

**Scope**

- 1 This Regulation shall apply to:
  - a the activities of feed business operators at all stages, from and including primary production of feed, up to and including, the placing of feed on the market;
  - b the feeding of food-producing animals;
  - c imports and exports of feed from and to third countries.
- 2 This Regulation shall not apply to:
  - a the private domestic production of feed:
    - (i) for food-producing animals kept for private domestic consumption;
    - and
    - (ii) for animals not kept for food production;
  - b the feeding of food-producing animals kept for private domestic consumption or for the activities mentioned in Article 1(2)(c) of Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 on the hygiene of foodstuffs<sup>(1)</sup>;
  - c the feeding of animals not kept for food production;
  - d the direct supply of small quantities of primary production of feed at local level by the producer to local farms for use on those farms;
  - e the retailing of pet food.
