

Regulation (EC) No 183/2005 of the European Parliament
and of the Council of 12 January 2005 laying down
requirements for feed hygiene (Text with EEA relevance)

CHAPTER II

OBLIGATIONS

Article 4

General obligations

[^{F1} Feed business operators must ensure that all stages of production, processing and distribution under their control are carried out in accordance with relevant hygiene requirements laid down in retained EU law.]

2 When feeding food-producing animals, farmers shall take measures and adopt procedures to keep the risk of biological, chemical and physical contamination of feed, animals and animal products as low as reasonably achievable.
