## [<sup>XI</sup> TITLE II

### REGISTRATION OF SUBSTANCES

#### CHAPTER 1

##### **General obligation to register and information requirements**

##### *[<sup>XI</sup> Article 8*

##### **Only representative of a [<sup>F1</sup>non-Great British] manufacturer**

1 A natural or legal person established outside [<sup>F2</sup>Great Britain] who manufactures a substance on its own, in [<sup>F3</sup>mixtures] or in articles, formulates a [<sup>F3</sup>mixture] or produces an article that is imported into [<sup>F2</sup>Great Britain] may by mutual agreement appoint a natural or legal person established in [<sup>F2</sup>Great Britain] to fulfil, as his only representative, the obligations on importers under this Title.

2 The representative shall also comply with all other obligations of importers under this Regulation. To this end, he shall have a sufficient background in the practical handling of substances and the information related to them and, without prejudice to Article 36, shall keep available and up-to-date information on quantities imported and customers sold to, as well as information on the supply of the latest update of the safety data sheet referred to in Article 31.

3 If a representative is appointed in accordance with paragraphs 1 and 2, the [<sup>F4</sup>non-Great British] manufacturer shall inform the importer(s) within the same supply chain of the appointment. These importers shall be regarded as downstream users for the purposes of this Regulation. ]
