CHAPTER VII

TRAVELLING EXHIBITION CERTIFICATES

Article 30

Issue

- [FIThe management authority] may issue travelling exhibition certificates in respect of legally acquired specimens which form part of a travelling exhibition and which meet [FI at least one] of the following criteria:
 - a they were born and bred in captivity in accordance with Articles 54 and 55, or artificially propagated in accordance with Article 56;
- [F2 aa they were
 - i acquired in, or introduced into, a member State before the provisions relating to species listed in Appendices I, II or III to the Convention, or in Annex C to Regulation(EEC) No 3626/82, or in Annexes A, B and C to Regulation 338/97 (pre-exit) became applicable to them; and
 - ii acquired in, or introduced into, the United Kingdom before IP completion day; or
 - b they were acquired in, or introduced into, the [F3United Kingdom] before the provisions relating to species listed in Appendices I, II or III to the Convention, or in Annex C to Regulation (EEC) No 3626/82, or in Annexes A, B and C to [F4Regulation 338/97 (pre-exit)] became applicable to them.
- 2 In the case of live animals, a travelling exhibition certificate shall cover only one specimen.
- A continuation sheet shall be attached to the travelling exhibition certificate, for use in accordance with Article 35.
- [F54] In the case of specimens other than live animals, the management authority shall attach to the travelling exhibition certificate an inventory sheet displaying, in respect of each specimen, all the information required by boxes 8 to 18 of the model form set out in Annex III provided for in Implementing Regulation (EU) No 792/2012.]
