MUSICAL INSTRUMENT CERTIFICATE

[^{F1}Article 44p

Introduction of musical instruments into [^{F2}Great Britain] with certificates issued by third countries

The introduction into [^{F3}Great Britain] of a musical instrument shall not require the presentation of an export document or an import permit provided that it is covered by a musical instrument certificate issued by a third country under similar conditions to those set out in Articles 44h and 44j. Re-export of that musical instrument shall not require the presentation of a re-export certificate.]
