MUSICAL INSTRUMENT CERTIFICATE

[F1 Article 44p]

Introduction of musical instruments into [F2Great Britain] with certificates issued by third countries

The introduction into [F3Great Britain] of a musical instrument shall not require the presentation of an export document or an import permit provided that it is covered by a musical instrument certificate issued by a third country under similar conditions to those set out in Articles 44h and 44j. Re-export of that musical instrument shall not require the presentation of a re-export certificate.]
