Commission Regulation (EC) No 1359/2007 of 21 November 2007 laying down the conditions for granting special export refunds on certain cuts of boned meat of bovine animals (Codified version)

## Article 6

- Customs formalities for export from the Community for supplies as referred to in Article 36 of Regulation (EC) No 800/1999 or for products placed under the customs warehousing procedure prior to export referred to in Commission Regulation (EC) No 1741/2006<sup>(1)</sup> shall be completed in the Member State in which the declaration as referred to in Article 3 is accepted.
- 2 In box 11 of the 'boned meat certificate' the customs authorities shall enter the reference numbers and dates of the declarations referred to in Article 5(4) of Regulation (EC) No 800/1999.
- After customs formalities covering the quantity of cuts for export are completed, the 'boned meat certificate' shall be sent by administrative channels to the agency responsible for paying the export refunds.
