

Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 October 2009 laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 (Animal by-products Regulation)

##### *Article 6*

##### General animal health restrictions

1 Animal by-products and derived products from susceptible species shall not be dispatched from holdings, establishments, plants or zones which are subject to restrictions:

- a pursuant to [<sup>F1</sup>veterinary legislation forming part of retained EU law]; or
- b due to the presence of a serious transmissible disease:
  - i listed in Annex I to Directive 92/119/EEC; or
  - ii [<sup>F2</sup>provided for by Article 4 of the Implementing Regulation; or
  - iii laid down in regulations made by the appropriate authority under the second subparagraph.]

[<sup>F3</sup>The appropriate authority may, by regulations, impose restrictions prohibiting animal by-products and derived products from susceptible species from being dispatched from a holding, establishment, plant or zone specified in the regulations.]

2 Paragraph 1 shall not apply where animal by-products and derived products are dispatched under conditions designed to prevent the spread of diseases transmissible to humans or animals [<sup>F4</sup>as laid down in regulations made by the appropriate authority under the second subparagraph].

[<sup>F5</sup>Where the appropriate authority considers it necessary or expedient to impose conditions to prevent the spread of a disease that is transmissible from animals to humans, the appropriate authority may, by regulations, impose conditions that must be complied with when animal by-products and derived products from susceptible species are being dispatched from a holding, establishment, plant or zone.]
