SECTION 3

*Unacceptable co-formulants*

Article 27

**Co-formulants**

1 A co-formulant shall not be accepted for inclusion in a plant protection product where it has been established that:

- a its residues, consequent on application consistent with good plant protection practice, and having regard to realistic conditions of use, have a harmful effect on human or animal health or on groundwater or an unacceptable effect on the environment; or
- b its use, consequent on application consistent with good plant protection practice and having regard to realistic conditions of use, has a harmful effect on human or animal health or an unacceptable effect on plants, plant products or the environment.

2 Co-formulants which are not accepted for inclusion in a plant protection product pursuant to paragraph 1 shall be included [<sup>F1</sup>on the unacceptable co-formulants register].

3 [<sup>F2</sup>A competent authority may review co-formulants which are not accepted in the competent authority's constituent territory for inclusion in a plant protection product at any time.][<sup>F3</sup>The competent authority] may take into account relevant information provided by [<sup>F4</sup>the other competent authorities].

[<sup>F6</sup>5 The appropriate authority may, by regulations, make provision necessary for the implementation of this Article.]
