Emergency situations in plant protection

By way of derogation from Article 28, in special circumstances a [F1 competen
authority] may authorise, for a period not exceeding 120 days, the placing on the market or
plant protection products, for limited and controlled use [F2in its constituent territory], where
such a measure appears necessary because of a danger which cannot be contained by any other
reasonable means.

The [F3 competent authority] concerned shall immediately inform the other [F4 competent authorities] of the measure taken, providing detailed information about the situation and any measures taken to ensure consumer safety.
