CHAPTER 2

Specific rules

Article 45

Specific disadvantages affecting farmers in the dairy, beef and veal, sheepmeat and goatmeat and rice sectors

- When establishing eligibility conditions for specific support to address specific disadvantages affecting farmers in the dairy, beef and veal, sheepmeat and goatmeat and rice sectors in economically vulnerable or environmentally sensitive areas, or, in the same sectors, for economically vulnerable types of farming under Article 68(1)(b) of Regulation (EC) No 73/2009, Member States shall define the economically vulnerable and/or environmentally sensitive areas and/or the economically vulnerable types of farming eligible for the support, taking into account in particular, the relevant production structures and conditions.
- 2 The specific support shall not be based on fluctuations of market prices or be equivalent to a deficiency payments system.
