Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1252/2009 of 18 December 2009 concluding the new exporter review of Regulation (EC) No 1338/2006 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of chamois leather originating in the People's Republic of China, levying retroactively and imposing an anti-dumping duty with regard to imports from one exporter in this country and terminating the registration of these imports

## Article 1

- The new exporter review initiated by Regulation (EC) No 573/2009 is hereby concluded, and an anti-dumping duty set at the level of the anti-dumping duty applicable according to Article 1(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1338/2006 to all companies in the People's Republic of China is hereby imposed on imports identified in Article 1 of Regulation (EC) No 573/2009.
- An anti-dumping duty set at the level of the anti-dumping duty applicable according to Article 1(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1338/2006 to all companies in the People's Republic of China is hereby levied with effect from 3 July 2009 on imports of chamois leather which have been registered pursuant to Article 3 of Regulation (EC) No 573/2009.
- 3 The customs authorities are hereby directed to cease the registration carried out pursuant to Article 3 of Regulation (EC) No 573/2009.
- 4 Unless otherwise specified, the provisions in force concerning customs duties shall apply.
