## COUNCIL REGULATION (EU) No 1048/2011

of 20 October 2011

**repealing Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004 imposing certain restrictive measures in support of effective implementation of the mandate of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY)**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Article 215 thereof,

Having regard to Council Decision 2010/603/CFSP of 7 October 2010 on further measures in support of the effective implementation of the mandate of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY) <sup>(1)</sup>,

Having regard to the joint proposal of the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy and the European Commission,

Whereas:

- (1) Council Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004 <sup>(2)</sup> gives effect to Decision 2010/603/CFSP by freezing the assets of certain individuals, in support of the ICTY mandate.

- (2) Decision 2010/603/CFSP expired on 10 October 2011.

- (3) It is therefore appropriate to repeal Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004 with immediate effect,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004 is hereby repealed.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
