### SUBSTANCES OR PRODUCTS CAUSING ALLERGIES OR INTOLERANCES

- [<sup>F1</sup>1. Cereals containing gluten, namely: wheat (such as spelt and khorasan wheat), rye, barley, oats or their hybridised strains, and products thereof, except:]
- (a) wheat based glucose syrups including dextrose<sup>(1)</sup>;
  - (b) wheat based maltodextrins<sup>(1)</sup>;
  - (c) glucose syrups based on barley;
  - (d) cereals used for making alcoholic distillates including ethyl alcohol of agricultural origin;
