THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1005/2008 of 29 September 2008 establishing a Community system to prevent, deter and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing⁽¹⁾, in particular Articles 12(4), 14(3), 20(4) and 52 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Administrative arrangements with third countries on catch certificates for fisheries products are listed in Annex IX to Commission Regulation (EC) No 1010/2009 of 22 October 2009 laying down detailed rules for the implementation of Regulation (EC) No 1005/2008⁽²⁾.
- (2) Two new administrative arrangements on catch certificates, based on electronic traceability systems, have been agreed with Norway and South Africa respectively on 4 May 2011 and 21 September 2010.
- (3) Annex IX to Regulation (EC) No 1010/2009 should be amended accordingly.
- (4) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Committee for Fisheries and Aquaculture,
