#### Suspension of approval of the conformity checks

The [<sup>F1</sup>Secretary of State] may suspend approval of the conformity checks if it is found that, in a significant number of lots and/or quantities, the goods do not correspond to the information in the certificates of conformity issued by the third country inspection bodies.
